

## Errata

On page 164, 171, and 191, it says that  $n_{t_f}$  and  $n_{t_p}$  represent the total number of failing and passing tests respectively. However, in the formulas as presented in this thesis,  $n_{t_f}$  and  $n_{t_p}$  stand for the number of times an expression was *not* involved in a failing or passing test respectively. They should be replaced with  $n_{u_f}$  and  $n_{u_p}$  to indicate that the expression is uninvolved.
